Scale of Uniform to P. H. II.

Your reference is requested to paragraph 1 of Divisional Circular No. Pub/6/167/55 of 16.8.55 addressed to all Officers with regard to scale of uniforms for Public Health Staff. According to this the existing approved quota of Uniform to P.H.II. is as follows:-

White suits	1 (or 7½ yards drill)	} per annum
Khaki shorts (pairs)	2 (or 4 yards drill)	
Khaki shirts	2 (or 7½ yards twill)	
Khaki Hose (pairs)	2	
Leather belt	1	} Once in four years
Khaki Helmet	1	
White Helmet	1	
Rain coat	1	} Once in five years

2. On representations made by the Public Health Inspectors' Union with regard to the inadequacy of their quota of uniforms, Treasury Authority was sought to give an additional quota. The Treasury has now approved the issue of the following quota of uniforms to the Public Health Inspectors :-

Once a year the following items:

White suits	- 2
Khaki shirts	- 2
Khaki shorts	- 2
Khaki hose (pairs)	- 2
Khaki Bush coats	- 2
Khaki coats	- 2
Peak Cap white and or Khaki cover	- 2

Once in five years

Khaki Helmet	- 1
White Helmet	- 1
Rain Coat	- 1
Leather Bag	- 1
